February 11th Workshop - Julie Gilbert Pollard - "Rock Gardens in Watercolor"



Phoenix artist, *Julie Gilbert Pollard*, paints in oil, watercolor and acrylic in a fluid, painterly manner. Her painting style, while representational, is colored with her own personal concept of reality. "The eye may see as a camera 'sees', but the mind's eye sees an altered, imagined image, what it wants and hopes to see. It's that illusive image, uniquely mine, along with a heightened sense of 'realness' that I try

to express in my paintings. This world of ours is often a frightening and mysterious place, but it is filled with scenes and subjects that excite my eye and imagination! The magical allure of the natural world, and my reverence for it, compel me to attempt to capture its essence on canvas or paper."



Julie is the author of two "best seller" North Light Books, "Watercolor Unleashed" (2013) and "Brilliant Color" (oil & acrylic, 2009). Due for release in April 2016, also North Light Books, is "Discover Oil





"Thank You!" John Erwin

On Saturday, November 12, 2016 John Erwin held his "Cityscapes, Parks and People" AWA Member One Day Workshop.

John had everyone who participated attempt to step out of their normal comfort zones and paint quickly with less controlled detail. We started the workshop with a quick lesson on 2 point perspective using a string and a paper clip.

We quickly moved on to painting freely with a lot of warm colors to create the autumn trees in a city park scene. A little salt was thrown in the wet paint to start creating some texture in the trees.

John Erwin's enthusiasm and fun style of teaching was contagious as we then created groups of "little" people standing in front of the trees.

John's number one advice on painting these people in the scene were to make sure we painted long legs and not make heads too big for the bodies. All was done rather abstractly while staying away from too much detail and worry. Black ink was then used sparingly to suggest some tree trunks and branches and add interest to the scene.

John also demonstrated painting two city scenes. The first city waterscape used only one color, "Paynes Gray", to create a rich monotone painting. The second demonstration was a multi-colored cityscape. The workshop attendees then could decide which scene to recreate in their own style.Last but not least, everyone was given a piece of plexi plastic with the "Albertian Veil" 3 point perspective lines drawn on it. This perspective point of view dates back to the 15th century and proves quite useful when painting tight alley ways in city scenes.
