Get ready to have a fun filled day painting Desert Blooms with Yvonne Joyner. Yvonne teaches a spontaneous painting style. The first part of the workshop will focus on a loose painting style detaching from the photo reference to design a "painting" and not a "copy". In the next phase, other materials such as water-soluble inks and color sticks

will be introduced to encourage a more experimental and expressive interpretation of a desert bloom.

According to Yvonne, "Watercolor drips, flows and splashes, and has an element of surprise and excitement. We will interpret the subject by watching the paper and responding intuitively.
