
President's Message



Welcome to 2018! Every year I say the same thing: I can't believe it's a new year! It's a time of reviewing last year's accomplishments and perhaps setting goals for the upcoming year. So, what are your art goals? I once took a workshop with Harley Brown, who made us take the Harley Oath: "I promise I will draw (paint) daily". How many times have I failed at that promise! But I keep trying. This is manageable if you think "PAINT".

SMALL." If we try, we can find twenty minutes in our day. This is a fantastic way to loosen up, experiment with new techniques, colors, and certainly stay connected with our art. I shared this idea with a friend who is recovering from a major illness and she thought it was wonderful idea;

she has been so focused on her recovery she feared she would have difficulty getting reconnected with her art. She suggested I share this with our members. The photo is a variation on one of my travel journals. Instead of using my traditional spiral bound journal, I cut watercolor paper into separate 4" square sections; I sketched and painted daily (sometimes more than once), included the date on each sketch and when finished, assembled it into a calendar. DYANNE LOCATI: A BOLD AND INOVATIVE ARTIST MEMBER WORKSHOP INSTRUCTOR FEBRUARY 10, 2018

I had the thrill of a lifetime yesterday when I visited Dyanne at her home and studio in Sun City West. Her home was an art Gallery in itself and her studio was resplendent with her art work on display and her tools of the trade. I was most impressed with her ability to put her hands on various items as we spoke about them. The explanations of her style and her work habits were meticulous. One could tell that her experience and expertise was vast and through.

Dyanne stated that she was "always" interested in art. She thought perhaps she would go into interior design. This may have been the catalyst for her extensive art education. She stated that education has been an important role in her career. She continues to take workshops, seminars and classes. She also continues to teach workshops and jury both colored pencil and mixed media art shows locally and nationally. She is a signature member of numerous organizations and has held important positions in various astute art organizations. For five years she owned and operated the Locati Art Center in Oregon.

Dyanne likes to work in a series. She finds that this practice offers her numerous ideas as she investigates new interpretations. She is presently involved in ideas of nature. She uses color and value to lead the viewer thru her painting. Her use of fluid acrylic, watercolor and pencil is dramatic. Her paintings are bold, atmospheric, and intuitive. The viewer will go back numerous times and receive a different experience; a different awareness. To me this is the epitome of being pulled into a painting and being surrounded by its narrative.

Dyanne feels that the role of the instructor is to guide the student in discovering new and exciting variations and interpretations of their own adventure in art. It is overwhelmingly apparent to me that Dyanne will lead the class to greater confidence and freedom in their art adventure. We are fortunate to have someone of her caliber and dedication in our organization.



"Serendipity in the Desert"~ Thank You Yvonne Joyner!

Yvonne's passion and enthusiasm for painting the Sonoran desert was definitely contagious in AWA's recent Saturday workshop. According to Yvonne, capturing the light of the desert is key to an illuminated cactus painting! She begins with a quick value sketch simplifying her reference into 3 values. She states our job as an artist should be to "create a painting, don't just record nature"! After drawing her sketch onto watercolor paper,

Yvonne begins splashing in color and letting the pigments mixand move on the paper. Yvonne believes the key elements to a successful painting are to paint quickly; use bigger brushes; use a combination of hard and soft edges (blur some details/ more water), put it down and get out and most importantly, "Enjoy the Journey"!




