


In November 2024, the AWA member workshop will feature Melanie Harman as the artist instructor. While Melanie has demonstrated talent in capturing various subjects in watercolor, she is also known for her outstanding collage work. Her workshop will utilize gel printed paper collage to embellish our artwork.

Expand your artistic skills through participation in this unique workshop!

There are also three new member workshops coming for the spring season of 2025. They are currently posted on the AWA website.

In January, Marion Droge will conduct a workshop titled "Reflective Surfaces". Marion has shown her expertise in mastering metallic reflective surfaces in a previous workshop. She is an excellent instructor as well as an award-winning artist.





In February, Grace Haverty will hold her workshop titled "Flowers Free and Loose". Grace is a nationally recognized signature watercolor artist. Her work has been represented numerous times in both regional organizations, such as the Western Federation of Watercolor Societies, and in national exhibitions.
